



WAREHOUSE/LOGISTICS TRAINING PROGRAM

Through the Warehouse Logistics Training Program, students will represent Feeding Tampa Bay as a customer service representative to all partner agencies, donors, and the public. Training will include processing orders, receiving, storing, and handling all inventories in accordance with all applicable policies, procedures, standards, and program guidelines, as well as general equipment and facility maintenance.

Over a 10-week training period, students will learn how to operate equipment (baler and compactor, forklift, cherry picker, pallet jack), build computer skills, learn ServSafe guidelines, complete order fulfillment in cold storage and dry storage, and count and receive inventory. Courses will also cover life skills, financial literacy, and customer service to prepare candidates for the workforce.

PROGRAM TRAINING HOURS AND STIPEND

- > Length of Training (10 Weeks)
- > 304 Hours of Instruction (160 Classroom/144 Hands-On)
- > Stipend: \$12.00/hour (6 hours per day)
- > Stipend paid every 2 weeks

TRAINING FACILITY

The Warehouse Training Program will be held at Feeding Tampa Bay between the hours of 8:30am-3:00pm Monday-Friday.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES

Each participant that completes the Warehouse/Logistics Program will receive at least 6 certifications:

- > MSSC CLA Certification (Certified Logistics Associate)
- > MSSC CLT Certification (Certified Logistics Technician)
- > OSHA 10 Certification
- > Forklift Certification
- > ServSafe Food Handler's Certification
- > Employment Readiness/Life Skills Training/Customer Service
