A qualified candidate will participate in various stages of content planning, gathering, and editing.

This is an immersive opportunity for someone with a passion for photography, people and philanthropic work. This position offers a first-hand experience, “boots on the ground” journey into our day to day operation. Candidates should be prepared to work in a fast-paced team environment and will finish the internship having gained broad experience in various aspects of thoughtful content production, creative workflow, portrait and action photography, and community interaction at a non-profit organization.

Responsibilities

- Support content team in the planning and execution of gathering impactful imagery of our work in the community.
- Travel to different sites to gather content in 10 different counties in west central Florida (sites include: agency partners, mega pantries, mobile pantries, community programs)
- Adopt and apply brand consistency and photo style to all content
- Provide imagery to support social media and marketing collateral efforts
- Assist in creative planning and execution for Instagram Reels
- Actively looking for creative ways to show the work we do through photography

Requirements

- Must provide your own equipment
- Ability to travel between 10 different counties in west central florida.
- Knowledge of DSLR camera, photography principles, portrait/action photography, use of natural lighting and editing.
- Adobe Creative Suite, Photoshop and Google Drive
- Comfortable taking photos of people.
- Ability to represent Feeding Tampa Bay publicly
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to take direction, multi-task, and work diligently to deliver content
- Driven and hard-working
